

## Scoring Rubric

Part I. Calculate your **Overall Score**.

Add up your total points on the Self-Assessment.

- If you received 0-3 points, you are in *Early Tech*.
- If you received 4-7 points, you are in *Developing Tech*.
- If you received 8-10 points, you are in *Target Tech*.

Part II. Discover your detailed and unique **EdTech Locator profile**.

Regardless of your overall score, you may find that where you fall on the Locator differs for specific job responsibilities. For example, if your overall score puts you in the “Developing Tech” category, you may still find that you are in “Early Tech” for one responsibility and “Target Tech” for another. Determining where you fall on the Locator for each of the responsibilities is an important step in determining where to focus your energies in order to move to the next level.
